DAY 1: FLY OVERNIGHT TO FRANCE

DAY 2: PARIS

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa. Then, admire the Notre Dame Cathedral's sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.

- Visit Notre Dame Cathedral

DAY 3: PARIS

- Take a fashion-focused guided tour of the Louvre, one of Paris's biggest attractions and the most visited museum in the world.
 Built to defend the city in the 13th century, today the Louvre safeguards collections that span continents and the ages. Enter by I.M. Pei's glass pyramid, considered a controversial addition by many resident Parisians. Inside, discover Greek, Roman and Asian antiquities, as well as precious objects from the Middle Ages. These massive halls are home to over 35,000 objects; among them is Leonardo da Vinci's masterpiece, the Mona Lisa.
 Be sure to get an up-close look at her beguiling smile.

DAY 5: PARIS

- -Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower
- ◆ Optional: Versailles. Nobody does decadence like Louis XIV, and there's no better testament to this than Versailles. Under the direction of the Sun King, the château that began as a modest hunting lodge exploded into one of the largest palaces on earth. On your excursion to this lavish estate, explore the state apartments of the king and queen and the magnificent Hall of Mirrors. Walk through the meticulously landscaped gardens and marvel at dozens of ornate fountains. Discover why Versailles was more than just a vacation home: Louis XIV hosted his royal court here to reign in their power and prevent their political rise.

DAY 6: PARIS

 Visit a Parisian fashion school. Get an inside look at an establishment dedicated to fashion study and innovation. See the past, present and future of the Parisian fashion industry on a guided tour of the campus.

DAY 7: PARIS

- Meet with a Parisian fashion designer. Vuitton, Chanel, Dior, Laurent—the influential designers from Paris is a definitive "who's who" of the fashion world. Boasting the same talent and flair as its forerunners, Paris' next generation of designers is primed to make the same indelible imprints on the industry in the coming years. Gain some insight from a rising fashion star on this visit.


