ATHENS & THE ISLANDS

10 or 13 days | Greece

DAY 1: FLY OVERNIGHT TO GREECE

DAY 2: ATHENS

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Athens and discover the ancient city named for Athena, goddess of war and wisdom. During your stay you'll visit the Acropolis to view the Parthenon, perhaps the world's greatest architectural feat. See the Temple of Athena Nike, which once housed a gold statue of the goddess, her wings clipped to prevent her from deserting the city. Snap a picture of the Presidential Guard in traditional costume, then pass the stadium that hosted the first modern Olympics in 1896. You'll also have the chance to see the Temple of Olympian Zeus, built in 515 B.C. to honor the most powerful of all Greek gods.
- Take a walking tour of Athens: Plaka district; Temple of Olympian Zeus

DAY 3: ATHENS

- Take an expertly guided tour of Athens: Olympic Stadium
- Visit the Acropolis: Parthenon; Temple of Athena Nike
- Visit the Acropolis Museum
- Optional: Greek cooking class

DAY 4: ATHENS

- Take a guided excursion to Delphi and visit the archaeological site and museum centered around the Oracle of Delphi, one of the most important landmarks of antiquity. The philosopher Socrates claimed to consult with the Oracle here and ancient military leaders left offerings in the hopes of earning luck in battle. Ponder the mysteries that lie in your future as you climb the ruins of the Temple of Apollo. According to legend, this is where the gods chose to communicate with mortals. See a variety of artifacts dating back to 550 B.C. at the Delphi Museum, and learn more about the mythical past of Greece.
- Visit Amfissa Valley and see olive groves (summer only)

DAY 5: ATHENS | MYKONOS

- Board your cruise ship for a four-day cruise that will take you to the islands and coastal towns of Greece. Enjoy on-board activities as you sail to Mykonos, Samos, Patmos, Rhodes, Crete and Santorini. Beautiful crystalline waters and white sand beaches helped make these destinations prized—and disputed territories. Roman and Greek influences helped shape the unique blend of cultures you'll encounter. At points of disembarkation, choose to enhance your experience with optional shore excursion packages to St. John's Grotto, Rhodes and Lindos and Oia Village. Additional excursions will be offered by the cruise line.

- Visit the Temple of Poseidon
- Optional: Attend a Greek Evening
